**What, if anything, do you think your son/daughter has gained from attending the sessions at RSG?**

- Skill of Jewellery Making, wants some beads and bits so she can carry on at home making her own jewellery.
- Bit more confidence
- A new skill, and something she would like to carry on with
- Gained new friendships, learnt new skills
- Learning new skills, meeting new people, creativity
- Being more creative
